Policy Statement

We are committed to upholding fundamental human rights and ethical labour practices, and we expect the same commitment from all our employees, suppliers, contractors, and business partners.

Responsibilities

Senior management is responsible for ensuring that this policy is effectively communicated throughout the organisation and integrated into relevant business processes.

All employees are responsible for familiarising themselves with this policy, reporting any concerns related to modern slavery, and cooperating with investigations as necessary.

Risk Assessment

Safer Site Solutions will conduct regular risk assessments to identify, assess, and mitigate modern slavery risks within its operations and supply chain. This includes evaluating the labour practices of suppliers, conducting site visits, and engaging with high-risk suppliers to promote ethical labour standards.

Due Diligence

Safer Site Solutions will implement due diligence processes to assess and monitor its supply chain for modern slavery risks. This includes:

Assessing supplier compliance with our Modern Slavery Policy through supplier questionnaires, audits, and other appropriate measures.

Providing training and guidance to employees involved in procurement and supply chain management to recognize and address modern slavery risks.

Collabourating with suppliers to address any identified risks and support them in improving their labour practices.





Transparency and Reporting

Safer Site Solutions is committed to transparency in its efforts to combat modern slavery. We will publish an annual Modern Slavery Statement detailing our actions to address modern slavery risks, including any incidents identified and steps taken to remedy them. This statement will be accessible to the public on our website.
